

MINUTES

A special meeting of the City Council of the City of Pinehurst was held on June 23, 2020 at 5:30p.m. via teleconference. A quorum having been established, Mayor Dan Mohon called the meeting to order with the following council members present: Sarah McClendon, T.W. Permenter, J. Michael Shahan and Cynthia Adams. Councilman John Zerko was absent. The following business was transacted.

On consideration of extending the SARS-CoV2, COVID-19 Public Health Disaster Declaration, Interim City Administrator Jerry Hood stated that the last meeting had extended the declaration for 30 days, taking it to the end of June. Mr. Hood recommended extending the declaration for an additional 90 days, which would be good through the end of September 2020. He stated that this recommendation was simply to eliminate the amount of meetings necessary to keep the declaration active. On a motion made by Mayor Pro Tem T.W. Permenter and seconded by Councilman J. Michael Shahan, council members unanimously voted to approve a 90 day extension of the SARS-CoV2, COVID-19 Public Health Disaster Declaration.

There being no further business to transact, Mayor Mohon adjourned the meeting at 5:33p.m.
