MINUTES

A special meeting of the City Council of the City of Pinehurst was held on September 17, 2025, at 6:00p.m. at Pinehurst City Hall Council Room. The following council members were present: Sarah McClendon, Cynthia Adams, J. Michael Shahan, Joey Vance, Troy Pierce, and Greg Willis. Mayor Sarah McClendon called the meeting to order and established a quorum. CouncilwomanCynthia Adams gave the invocation followed by the reciting of the United States and Texas Pledges of Allegiance. The following business was transacted.

At 6:05 p.m. council members convened in a closed meeting pursuant to the Texas Local Government Code Section 551.074, Personnel Matters to review suspension of Stephen Stroud as Police Chief and Acting City Administrator, discussion about interim Police Chief and discussion about interim Acting City Administrator.

At 7:48 p.m., council members reconvened in open session. The review of suspension of Stephen Stroud as Police Chief and Acting City Administrator, Mayor Pro-Tem J. Michael Shahan stated that they had come to a preliminary agreement with Mr. Stroud. On a motion made by Mayor Pro-Tem J. Michael Shahan and seconded by Councilman Greg Willis, council members voted to authorize City Attorney Tommy Gunn to finalize the details of that agreement and to bring back those details to the next council meeting for ratification by the Council. The next item was to act on an Interim Police Chief, this item was asked to be tabled by Mayor Pro-Tem J. Michael Shahan. The last item was action for an Interim City Administrator, Councilman Troy Pierce made a motion to appoint Robbie Hood as Interim City Administrator with a salary of \$72,000 plus benefits. Councilman Joey Vance seconded this motion and the motion unanimously passed.

There were no announcements, comments or requests from Council.

There being no further business to transact, Councilman Greg Willis made a motion to adjourn. Mayor McClendon adjourned the meeting at 7:50 p.m.
